CD79A (202-216) Mouse Monoclonal Antibody [Clone ID: HM57] - AM01322RP-T

Background: The CD79a molecule associates with CD79b (B29) to form a heterodimer that is non-

covalently linked to surface immunoglobulin, forming the B-cell receptor (BCR) complex. The CD79a/CD79b heterodimers are also necessary for intracellular signalling following antigen-

binding to surface immunoglobulin.

Synonyms: IGA, MB1, B-Cell marker
