intracellularly.

This antibody also detects Subpopulation of Macrophages of Rhesus Monkey.

**Formulation:** PBS, pH 7.4

State: Purified

State: Lyophilized purified IgG fraction from Cell Culture Supernatant

Preservative: 0.09% Sodium Azide

**Reconstitution Method:** Restore in aqua bidest to 1 mg/ml

**Purification:** Protein G Chromatography

Conjugation: Unconjugated

**Storage:** Store lyophilized at 2-8°C for 6 months or at -20°C long term.

After reconstitution store the antibody undiluted at 2-8°C for one month

or (in aliquots) at -20°C long term. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

**Stability:** Shelf life: one year from despatch.





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Background: MRP8 and MRP14 are members of the S100 family of proteins containing 2 EF hand calcium

binding motifs. S100 proteins are localized in the cytoplasm and/or nucleus of a wide range of cells, and involved in the regulation of a number of cellular processes such as cell cycle progression and differentiation. S100 genes include at least 13 members which are located as

a cluster on chromosome 1q21.
