
Background:

Beta Amyloid A4 (APP) is the principle protein implicated in the development of Alzheimer's disease; a debilitating neurodegenerative condition characterized by the loss of cognitive skills and severe behavioral changes (dementia). Beta Amyloid A4 is a cell surface receptor and transmembrane precursor protein that is cleaved by secretases to form a number of peptides. Some of these peptides are secreted and can bind to the acetyltransferase complex APBB1/TIP60 to promote transcriptional activation, while others form the protein basis of the amyloid plaques found in the brains of patients with Alzheimer disease. Mutations in this gene have been implicated in autosomal dominant Alzheimer disease and cerebroarterial amyloidosis (cerebral amyloid angiopathy).


