Glypican-4 from other species, like Mouse.

Formulation: State: Serum

State: Lyophilized serum

Reconstitution Method: Restore in aqua bidest to initial volume.

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Storage: Store lyophilized at 2-8°C for 6 months or at -20°C long term.

After reconstitution store the antibody undiluted at 2-8°C for one month

or (in aliquots) at -20°C long term. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Stability: Shelf life: one year from despatch.

Background: Glypican-4, previously known as K-glypican, is a GPI-linked cell surface heparan sulfate

proteoglycan of the glypican gene family, that comprises 6 members at present. Its function is only partially understood at present. However, glypican-4 seems to be involved in the control of cell growth and differen-tiation, especially in the development of the central nervous system and the kidney. Furthermore, glypican-4 is expressed by hematopoetic stem

cells and bone marrow stromal cells.
