Background: Macrophage inflammatory protein 5 (CCL15) is a member of the human beta-chemokine

family and is chemotactic for T cells and monocytes but not neutrophils, eosinophils, or B cells. It induces changes in intracellular calcium concentration in monocytes and is thought to

act through the CCR1 receptor but also binds to CCR3.
