Formulation: PBS (without Mg2+ and Ca2+), pH 7.4, 150 mM NaCl, 0.02% Sodium Azide and 50% Glycerol.

State: Aff - Purified

State: Liquid purified Ig fraction.

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Affinity Chromatography using epitope-specific phosphopeptide. The antibody against non-

phosphopeptide was removed by chromatography using non-phosphopeptide corresponding

to the phosphorylation site.

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Storage: Store the antibody (in aliquots) at -20°C.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Stability: Shelf life: One year from despatch.

Background:

LIMK1 is a protein kinase which regulates actin filament dynamics. Phosphorylates and inactivates the actin binding/depolymerizing factor cofilin, thereby stabilizing the actin cytoskeleton. LIMK1 may be involved in brain development; it is highly expressed in both adult and fetal nervous system. Detected ubiquitously throughout the different regions of adult brain, with highest levels in the cerebral cortex. Expressed to a lesser extent in heart and skeletal muscle.




Figure 2. Western blot analysis of extract from NIH/3T3 cells treated or untreated with UV (60min), using LIMK1 (phospho-Thr508) antibody.




Figure 1. Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin- embedded human breast carcinoma tissue, using LIMK1 (phospho-Thr508) antibody.






Figure 3. Immunofluorescence staining of methanol-fixed HeLa cells using LIMK1 (phospho-Thr508) antibody (Red).
