Immunodiffusion (Ouchterlony), block titration, ELISA, Immunoblotting and enzyme

inhibition.

Cross-reactivities against enzymes of other sources may occur but have not been

determined.

**Formulation:** PBS, pH 7.2 without preservatives and foreign proteins

Label: Biotin

State: Lyophilized hyperimmune IgG fraction

Molar radio: Biotin/IgG ~6.0

**Reconstitution Method:** Restore by adding 1.0 ml sterile distilled water

**Concentration:** lot specific

**Purification:** Ammonium Sulphate Precipitation and Ion Exchange Chromatography

## IPP1 Rabbit Polyclonal Antibody - AP21326BT-N

Storage: Store lyophilized at 2-8°C for 6 months or at -20°C long term.

After reconstitution store the antibody undiluted at 2-8°C for one month

or (in aliquots) at -20°C long term.

If a slight precipitation occurs upon storage, this should be removed by centrifugation.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

**Stability:** Shelf life: one year from despatch.

PPases catalyze the hydrolysis of pyrophosphate to inorganic phosphate, which is important

for the phosphate metabolism of cells.
