





Western blot analysis of FNDC7 Antibody (C-term) in HepG2 cell line lysates (35ug/lane). This demonstrates the FNDC7 antibody detected the FNDC7 protein (arrow).



Immunohistochemistry analysis in formalin fixed and paraffin embedded human rectum tissue reacted with FNDC7 Antibody (C-term) followed by peroxidase conjugation of the secondary antibody and DAB staining.
