Background: Aminoacyl-tRNA synthetases are a class of enzymes that charge tRNAs with their cognate

amino acids. Asparaginyl-tRNA synthetase is localized to the cytoplasm and belongs to the class II family of tRNA synthetases. The N-terminal domain represents the signature sequence


for the eukaryotic asparaginyl-tRNA synthetases.







Western blot analysis of NARS (arrow) using NARS Antibody (N-term). 293 cell lysates (2 ug/lane) either nontransfected (Lane 1) or transiently transfected (Lane 2) with the NARS gene.



Western blot analysis of NARS Antibody (N-term) in WiDr, HepG2 cell line lysates (35ug/lane). This demonstrates the NARS antibody detected the NARS protein (arrow).







Immunohistochemistry analysis in formalin fixed and paraffin embedded human hepatocarcinoma reacted with NARS Antibody (N-term), which was peroxidase conjugated to the secondary antibody and followed by DAB staining. This data demonstrates the use of NARS Antibody (N-term) for immunohistochemistry. Clinical relevance has not been evaluated.

Flow cytometric analysis of WiDr cells using NARS Antibody (N-term) (right histogram) compared to a negative control cell (left histogram). FITC-conjugated goat-anti-rabbit secondary antibodies were used for the analysis.
