Protein Description: Recombinant e.coli rnhA protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and

purified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

Storage: Store undiluted at 2-8°C for up to two weeks or (in aliquots) at -20°C or -70°C for longer.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Stability: Shelf life: one year from despatch.

Summary: rnhA is an endonuclease that specifically degrades the RNA of RNA-DNA hybrids. Localized to

the nucleus, this protein mediates the removal of Okazaki fragment RNA primers that are present on the lagging strand during DNA replication. rnhA catalyzes the endonucleolytic cleavage of RNA to a 5'-phosphomonoester and is able to bind magnesium or manganese as

cofactors.
