Purification: Purified from mouse ascites fluids or tissue culture supernatant by affinity chromatography

Background: This gene encodes a protein that catalyzes the final step in the conversion of vitamin B(12)


into adenosylcobalamin (AdoCbl), a vitamin B12-containing coenzyme for methylmalonyl-CoA mutase. Mutations in the gene are the cause of vitamin B12-dependent methylmalonic

aciduria linked to the cblB complementation group. [provided by RefSeq]






HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MMAB ([RC204290], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MMAB. Positive lysates [LY409455] (100ug) and [LC409455] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Anti-MMAB mouse monoclonal antibody ([TA502166]) immunofluorescent staining of COS7 cells transiently transfected by pCMV6-ENTRY MMAB ([RC204290]).





HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC204290] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-MMAB antibody ([TA502166]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
