Background:	This gene encodes a novel mitochondrial protein that interacts with reticulon 4, which is a potent inhibitor of regeneration following spinal cord injury. The interaction of reticulon 4 with mitochondrial proteins may provide insight into the mechanisms for reticulon-induced inhibition of neurite growth. [provided by RefSeq]. 



HepG2 HeLa SVT2 A549 COS7 Jurkat MDCK PC12 MCF7


HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY RTN4IP1 ([RC202957], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-RTN4IP1. Positive lysates [LY409966] (100ug) and [LC409966] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.

Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from 9 different cell lines by using anti-RTN4IP1 monoclonal antibody.



HEK293T cells transfected with either [RC202957] overexpress plasmid (Red) or empty vector control plasmid (Blue) were immunostained by anti-RTN4IP1 antibody ([TA502543]), and then analyzed by flow cytometry.
