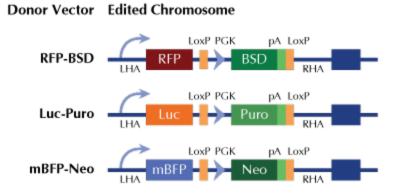

The encoded protein is thought to act as a regulator of breast cancer growth and progression by binding to a phosphorylated form of integrin beta4, a tumor- related antigen, targeting the integrin for internalization and degradation.
