Components: The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube

containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).

Reconstitution Method: 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.

2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.

3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.

4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid

at the bottom.

5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20 $^{\circ}$ C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of

shipping when stored at -20°C.

Gene Summary: Cytokine which is involved in epithelial-mesenchymal signaling during morphogenesis of

ectodermal organs. Functions as a ligand activating the DEATH-domain containing receptors EDAR and EDA2R. Isoform TAA binds only to the receptor EDAR, while isoform TA-A2 binds exclusively to the receptor EDA2R (By similarity). May also play a role in cell adhesion

Transcript Variant: This variant (7) lacks an in-frame segment in the CDS, as compared to variant 1. The resulting isoform (7) lacks an internal segment, as compared to isoform 1.
