## Tpm1 (NM\_001164254) Mouse Untagged Clone - MC209575

**Components:** The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube

containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).

**Reconstitution Method:** 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.

2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.

3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.

4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid

at the bottom.

5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of

shipping when stored at -20°C.

**Note:** Plasmids are not sterile. For experiments where strict sterility is required, filtration with

0.22um filter is required.

**Gene Summary:** Binds to actin filaments in muscle and non-muscle cells. Plays a central role, in association

with the troponin complex, in the calcium dependent regulation of vertebrate striated muscle contraction. Smooth muscle contraction is regulated by interaction with caldesmon. In non-muscle cells is implicated in stabilizing cytoskeleton actin filaments. [UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot

Transcript Variant: This variant (Tpm1.13, also known as variant 8) differs in the 5' and 3' UTRs as well as the 5' and 3' coding sequences compared to variant Tpm1.6. The encoded isoform (Tpm1.13) has alternate N- and C- termini and is shorter, compared to isoform Tpm1.6cy. Sequence Note: The RefSeq transcript and protein were derived from genomic sequence to

make the sequence consistent with the reference genome assembly. The genomic

coordinates used for the transcript record were based on alignments.
