Components: The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube

containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).





Reconstitution Method:

- 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.
- 2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.
- 3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.
- 4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid at the bottom.

5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of shipping when stored at -20°C.

Gene Summary: Required for endoplasmic reticulum integrity. Regulates the distribution of TOR1A between

the endoplasmic reticulum and the nuclear envelope as well as induces TOR1A, TOR1B and

TOR3A ATPase activity (By similarity).[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]

Transcript Variant: This variant (4) shares a portion of its 5' UTR, but uses a completely different set of coding exons compared to variant 5. Variant 4 encodes a shorter protein (interferon alpha responsive protein), which is distinct from torsin A interacting protein 2).

Variants 1-4 encode the same protein (isoform a).
