Gene Summary:This gene encodes a subunit of the homotetrameric enzyme aldolase B, an isozyme of the<br/>class I fructose 1,6-bisphosphate aldolase enzyme. This enzyme catalyzes the conversion of<br/>fructose 1,6-bisphosphate to dihydroxyacetone phosphate and glyceraldehyde 3-phosphate.<br/>Homozygous knockout mice for this gene exhibit liver damage and death following fructose<br/>ingestion. A pseudogene of this gene has been identified in the genome. [provided by RefSeq,<br/>Aug 2015]
