

| OTI Disclaimer:   | The molecular sequence of this clone aligns with the gene accession number as a point of reference only. | OTI Annotation:   | This clone was engineered to express the complete ORF with an expression tag. Expression varies depending on the nature of the gene.   |
| Components:   | The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).   |
| Reconstitution Method:  | <ol> <li>Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.</li> <li>Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.</li> <li>Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.</li> <li>Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid at the bottom.</li> <li>Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of shipping when stored at -20°C.</li> </ol> |

| Gene Summary:   | This gene encodes a liver-specific mitochondrial enzyme that catalyzes the conversion of L-<br>tyrosine into p-hydroxyphenylpyruvate. Regulated by glucocorticoid and polypeptide<br>hormones, this gene's expression is affected by deletion of a regulatory region near the<br>albino locus on chromosome 7.
