

Gene Summary:This gene encodes a flavin adenine dinucleotide-binding protein that is a key component of<br/>the circadian core oscillator complex, which regulates the circadian clock. This gene is<br/>upregulated by Clock/Arntl heterodimers but then represses this upregulation in a feedback<br/>loop using Per/Cry heterodimers to interact with Clock/Arntl. Polymorphisms in this gene<br/>have been associated with altered sleep patterns. The encoded protein is widely conserved<br/>across plants and animals. [provided by RefSeq, Feb 2014]
