Gene Summary:

Meiotic recombination factor component of recombination bridges involved in meiotic double-strand break repair (PubMed:32463460, PubMed:32460033). Modulates the localization of recombinases DMC1:RAD51 to meiotic double-strand break (DSB) sites through the interaction with and stabilization of the BRCA2:HSF2BP complex during meiotic recombination (PubMed:32460033, PubMed:32463460). Indispensable for the DSB repair, homologous synapsis, and crossover formation that are needed for progression past metaphase I, is essential for spermatogenesis and male fertility (PubMed:32463460, PubMed:32460033).[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]
