Gene Summary:

Metallocarboxypeptidase that mediates deglutamylation of target proteins. Catalyzes the deglutamylation of polyglutamate side chains generated by post-translational polyglutamylation in proteins such as tubulins. Also removes gene-encoded polyglutamates from the carboxy-terminus of target proteins such as MYLK. Acts as a long-chain deglutamylase and specifically shortens long polyglutamate chains, while it is not able to remove the branching point glutamate, a process catalyzed by AGL5/CCP5. Deglutamylation plays a key role in cerebellar Purkinje cell differentiation, accumulation of tubulin polyglutamylation causing neurodegeneration.[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]
