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Gene Summary:Olfactory receptors interact with odorant molecules in the nose, to initiate a neuronal<br/>response that triggers the perception of a smell. The olfactory receptor proteins are<br/>members of a large family of G-protein-coupled receptors (GPCR) arising from single coding-<br/>exon genes. Olfactory receptors share a 7-transmembrane domain structure with many<br/>neurotransmitter and hormone receptors and are responsible for the recognition and G<br/>protein-mediated transduction of odorant signals. The olfactory receptor gene family is the<br/>largest in the genome. The nomenclature assigned to the olfactory receptor genes and<br/>proteins for this organism is independent of other organisms.
