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Gene Summary:The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the CDK (cyclin-dependent kinase) subfamily of<br/>the Ser/Thr protein kinase family. The CDK subfamily members are highly similar to the gene<br/>products of S. cerevisiae cdc28, and S. pombe cdc2, and are known to be essential for cell<br/>cycle progression. The human ortholog has been shown to play a role in cellular proliferation.<br/>Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
