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Gene Summary:Metallocarboxypeptidase that mediates deglutamylation of target proteins<br/>(PubMed:17244818, PubMed:21074048, PubMed:25103237, PubMed:26829768). Catalyzes<br/>the deglutamylation of polyglutamate side chains generated by post-translational<br/>polyglutamylation in proteins such as tubulins (PubMed:17244818). Also removes<br/>polyglutamates from the carboxy-terminus of target proteins such as MYLK<br/>(PubMed:21074048). Mediates deglutamylation of CGAS, regulating the antiviral activity of<br/>CGAS (PubMed:26829768). Acts as a long-chain deglutamylase and specifically shortens long<br/>polyglutamate chains, while it is not able to remove the branching point glutamate, a process<br/>catalyzed by AGBL5/CCP5 (PubMed:25103237).[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]

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
