Gene Summary:

Receptor for the netrin NTN4 that promotes neuronal cell survival (PubMed:21216843). Plays a role in cell-cell adhesion and cell guidance. Receptor for netrin involved in cell migration (By similarity). Plays a role in the regulation of neuronal cell migration in the developing brain via its interaction with FLRT2 (PubMed:21673655). Plays a role in axon guidance by mediating axon repulsion of neuronal growth cones in the developing nervous system upon ligand binding (PubMed:21673655). May play a role in apoptosis in response to DNA damage. It also acts as a dependence receptor required for apoptosis induction when not associated with netrin ligand (By similarity). Mediates cell-cell adhesion via its interaction with FLRT3 on an adjacent cell (PubMed:26235030).[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]
