Gene Summary:

This gene encodes an RNA polymerase subunit that is a component of both the RNA polymerase I and RNA polymerase III complexes. RNA polymerase I is associated with transcription of pre-ribosomal RNAs, while RNA polymerase III is associated with transcription of small RNAs. Pseudogenes of this gene have been defined on chromosomes 4 and 6. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Feb 2013]
