Gene Summary:

Plays a role in the endoplasmic reticulum quality control (ERQC) system also called ER-associated degradation (ERAD) involved in ubiquitin-dependent degradation of misfolded endoplasmic reticulum proteins (PubMed:25066055, PubMed:24453213). Enhances SYVN1 stability (PubMed:24453213). Plays a role in LPL maturation and secretion (PubMed:25066055). Required for normal differentiation of the pancreas epithelium, and for normal exocrine function and survival of pancreatic cells (PubMed:20170518, PubMed:24453213). May play a role in Notch signaling (PubMed:20170518).[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]
