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Gene Summary:Transcriptional repressor. Recognizes and binds to the consensus sequence '5-<br/>[CG]NG[CG]GGGCA[CA]CC-3'. May act as a tumor suppressor. May be involved in<br/>development of head, face, limbs and ventral body wall. Involved in down-regulation of SIRT1<br/>and thereby is involved in regulation of p53/TP53-dependent apoptotic DNA-damage<br/>responses. The specific target gene promoter association seems to be depend on<br/>corepressors, such as CTBP1 or CTBP2 and MTA1. The regulation of SIRT1 transcription in<br/>response to nutrient deprivation seems to involve CTBP1. In cooperation with MTA1<br/>(indicative for an association with the NuRD complex) represses transcription from<br/>CCND1/cyclin-D1 and CDKN1C/p57Kip2 specifically in quiescent cells. Involved in regulation of<br/>the Wnt signaling pathway probably by association with TCF7L2 and preventing TCF7L2 and<br/>CTNNB1 association with promoters of TCF-responsive genes. Seems to repress transcription<br/>from E2F1 and ATOH1 which involves ARID1A, indicative for the participation of a distinct<br/>SWI/SNF-type chromatin-remodeling complex. Probably represses transcription from ACKR3,<br/>FGFBP1 and EFNA1.[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]

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
