Recommended Dilution: Neutralization: To yield one-half maximal inhibition [ND50] of the biological activity of

Human FGF-17 (200.0 ng/ml), a concentration of 2.1-3.2 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. **Sandwich ELISA:** To detect Human FGF-17 by Sandwich ELISA (using 100 μ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5-2.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with Biotinylated anti-Human FGF-17 (PP1130B1 or PP1130B2) as Detection antibody, allows the detection of 0.2-0.4 ng/well of recombinant

Human FGF-17.

Western Blot: To detect Human FGF-17 by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1- $0.2 \mu g/ml$. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant Human FGF-17 is 1.5-3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or

non-reducing conditions.

Formulation: PBS, pH 7.2 without preservatives.

State: Lyophilized (sterile filtered) purified lg fraction.

Reconstitution Method: Restore in sterile Water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Purification: Affinity Chromatography employing immobilized Human FGF-17 matrix.

Conjugation: Unconjugated

Storage: Store lyophilized at 2-8°C for 6 months or at -20°C long term.

After reconstitution store the antibody undiluted at 2-8°C for one month

or (in aliquots) at -20°C long term. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Stability: Shelf life: one year from despatch.

Background: FGF17 belongs to the heparin-binding growth factors family. It may be a signaling molecule in

the induction and patterning of the embryonic brain and is preferentially expressed in the

embryonic brain. There are two named isoforms.

Synonyms: Fibroblast growth factor 17, FGF-17
