Recommended Dilution: Neutralization.

ELISA: To detect hIL-20 by direct ELISA (using 100 μl/well antibody solution) a concentration of at least 0.5 µg/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, allows the detection of 0.2-0.4 ng/well of

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recombinant hIL-20.

Western Blot: To detect hIL-20 by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1-0.2 µg/ml. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hIL-20 is 1.5-3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-

reducing conditions.

Store the antibody prior to reconstitution at -20°C. Following reconstitution the antibody can Storage:

be stored at 2-8°C for one month or at -20°C for longer.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

Stability: Shelf life: one year from despatch.

IL20 Goat Polyclonal Antibody - PP1209P2

Background: IL20 is a cytokine structurally related to interleukin 10 (IL10). This cytokine has been shown to

transduce its signal through signal transducer and activator of transcription 3 (STAT3) in keratinocytes. A specific receptor for this cytokine is expressed in skin and upregulated dramatically in psoriatic skin, suggesting a role for this protein in epidermal function and

psoriasis.
