Recommended Dilution: Suitable for Immunoblotting (Western or Dot blot), ELISA, Immunoperoxidase electron

microscopy and Immunohistochemistry as well as other peroxidase-antibody based

enzymatic assays requiring lot-to-lot consistency.

Recommended Dilutions: This product has been assayed against 1.0 µg of Goat IgG in a standard capture ELISA using ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:7,000 to 1:35,000 of

the reconstitution concentration is suggested for this product.

Reactivity: Goat
Host: Rabbit

Immunogen: Goat IgG F(ab')2 fragment.

Formulation: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2, with 10 mg/ml Bovine Serum

Albumin (BSA, IgG and Protease free) as stabilizer and 0.01% (w/v) Gentamicin Sulfate as

preservative. Label: HRP

State: Lyophilized purified IgG fraction.

Label: Horseradish Peroxidase

Reconstitution Method: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Concentration: 2.0 mg/ml (by UV absorbance at 280 nm)

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography.

Conjugation: HRP

Storage: Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then

aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after

standing at room temperature.

This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
