Formulation: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2, with 0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide

as preservative and 10 mg/ml Bovine Serum Albumin (BSA) (IgG and Protease free) as

stabilizer.

Label: Texas Red

State: Lyophilized purified Ig fraction.

Label: (TM) Sulfonyl Chloride (Molecular Weight 625 daltons)

Absorption emission: 596 nm / 620 nm

Molar radio: 5.3 moles Texas Red per mole of Goat IgG.

Reconstitution Method: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography.

Conjugation: Texas Red

Storage: Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then

aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after

standing at room temperature.

This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
