Formulation: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2 with 10 mg/ml Bovine Serum

Albumin (BSA) (IgG and Protease free) as stabilizer and 0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide as

preservative. Label: FITC

State: Lyophilized purified Ig fraction.

Label: Fluorescein isothiocyanate (Molecular Weight 390 daltons)

Absorption emission: 495 nm / 528 nm

Molar radio: 2.6 moles FITC per mole of Goat IgG.

Reconstitution Method: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography.

Conjugation: FITC

Storage: Store vial at 4°C prior to restoration. For extended storage reconstitute product with 50%

glycerol instead of water and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature.

This antibody is stable for one month at 4°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing.
