Recommended Dilutions: This product has been assayed against 1.0 ug of Rat IgG in a standard capture ELISA using Peroxidase Conjugated Streptavidin and ABTS (2,2'-azino-bis-[3-ethylbenthiazoline-6-sulfonic acid]) as a substrate for 30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:20,000 to 1:110,000 of the reconstitution concentration is suggested for

this product.

Immunogen: Rat IgG whole molecule.

Formulation: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2 with 10 mg/ml Bovine Serum

Albumin (BSA) IgG and Protease free as stabilizer and 0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide as

preservative. Label: Biotin

State: Lyophilized Fab fragments.

Label: Biotinamidocaproate N-Hydroxysuccinimide Ester (BAC) Molar radio: 10-20 BAC molecules per Goat IgG Fab molecule.

Reconstitution Method: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography.

Conjugation: Biotin





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Storage:

Store vial at 4°C prior to restoration. For extended storage reconstitute product with 50% glycerol instead of water and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This antibody is stable for one month at 4°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing.
