antibody based fluorescent assays requiring lot-to-lot consistency.

Formulation: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2 containing 10 mg/ml Bovine

Serum Albumin (BSA, IgG and Protease free) as stabilizer and 0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide as

preservative. Label: TRITC

State: Lyophilized F(ab')2 fragments.

Label: Tetramethylrhodamine isothiocyanante (Molecular Weight 444 daltons)

Absorption emission: 550 nm / 570 nm

Molar radio: 1.2 moles TRITC per mole of Goat IgG.

Reconstitution Method: Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography.

Conjugation: TRITC

Storage: Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature.

This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
