Recommended Dilution: Suitable for Immunoblotting, ELISA, Immunohistochemistry, Immunomicroscopy as well as

other antibody based assays using streptavidin or avidin conjugates requiring extremely low background levels, absence of F(c) mediated binding, lot-to-lot consistency, high titer and

specificity.

Recommended Dilution(s): This product has been assayed against 1.0 µg of Rat IgG in a standard capture ELISA using Peroxidase Conjugated Streptavidin and ABTS as a substrate for

30 minutes at room temperature. A working dilution of 1:10,000 to 1:50,000 of the

reconstitution concentration is suggested.

Reactivity: Rat

Host: Rabbit

Immunogen: Rat IgG whole molecule

Formulation: 0.02 M Potassium Phosphate, 0.15 M Sodium Chloride, pH 7.2 containing 10 mg/ml BSA (IgG

and Protease free) as stabilizer and 0.01% (w/v) Sodium Azide preservative .

Label: Biotin

State: Lyophilized F(ab')2 fragments.

Label: Biotinamidocaproate N-Hydroxysuccinimide Ester (BAC) Molar radio: 10-20 BAC molecules per Rabbit IgG molecule.

Reconstitution Method: Restore with 0.5 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Concentration: lot specific

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography.

Conjugation: Biotin

Storage: Store vial at 2-8°C prior to restoration. Restore with 0.5 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

For extended storage add glycerol to 50% and then aliquot contents and freeze at -20°C or below. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature.

This antibody is stable for one month at 2-8°C as an undiluted liquid.

Dilute only prior to immediate use. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
