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Gene Summary:The protein encoded by this gene has an N-terminus that is similar to the multicopy<br/>associated filamentation (maf) protein of Bacillus subtilis and to orfE of Escherichia coli, while<br/>the C-terminus is similar to N-acetylserotonin O-methyltransferase. This gene is located in the<br/>pseudoautosomal region 1 (PAR1) of X and Y chromosomes. Three transcript variants<br/>encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
