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Gene Summary:This gene encodes a member of the WD repeat protein family. WD repeats are minimally<br/>conserved regions of approximately 40 amino acids typically bracketed by gly-his and trp-asp<br/>(GH-WD), which may facilitate formation of heterotrimeric or multiprotein complexes.<br/>Members of this family are involved in a variety of cellular processes, including cell cycle<br/>progression, signal transduction, apoptosis, and gene regulation. This gene has a<br/>pseudogene at chromosome 4q31.3. Multiple alternatively spliced transcript variants<br/>encoding distinct isoforms have been found for this gene, but the biological validity and full-<br/>length nature of some variants have not been determined.
