**Gene Summary:** This gene encodes the cytosolic form of a metalloaminopeptidase that catalyzes the cleavage

of the N-terminal amino acid adjacent to a proline residue. The gene product may play a role in degradation and maturation of tachykinins, neuropeptides, and peptide hormones. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.[provided by RefSeq, Nov 2009]
