Gene Summary:This gene, CYP4F11, encodes a member of the cytochrome P450 superfamily of enzymes. The<br/>cytochrome P450 proteins are monooxygenases which catalyze many reactions involved in<br/>drug metabolism and synthesis of cholesterol, steroids and other lipids. This gene is part of a<br/>cluster of cytochrome P450 genes on chromosome 19. Another member of this family,<br/>CYP4F2, is approximately 16 kb away. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding the<br/>same protein have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]
