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Gene Summary:This gene encodes a lipid-binding protein belonging to the apolipoprotein gene family. The<br/>protein is thought to play a role in lipid metabolism. Polymorphisms in this gene may<br/>influence circulating lipid levels and may be associated with coronary artery disease risk. This<br/>gene is present in a cluster with other related apolipoprotein genes on chromosome 19.<br/>Naturally occurring read-through transcription exists between this gene and the neighboring<br/>downstream apolipoprotein C-II (APOC2) gene.
