

**Gene Summary:** The protein encoded by this gene is a nuclear encoded endonuclease that is localized in the

mitochondrion. The encoded protein is widely distributed among animals and cleaves DNA at GC tracts. This protein is capable of generating the RNA primers required by DNA polymerase
