**Gene Summary:** This gene encodes a member of carboxypeptidase A protein family. The encoded protein

may function as a transcriptional repressor and play a role in adipogenesis and smooth muscle cell differentiation. Studies in mice suggest that this gene functions in wound healing

and abdominal wall development. Overexpression of this gene is associated with
