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Gene Summary:This gene belongs to subfamily P of the forkhead box (FOX) transcription factor family.<br/>Forkhead box transcription factors play important roles in the regulation of tissue- and cell<br/>type-specific gene transcription during both development and adulthood. Many members of<br/>the forkhead box gene family, including members of subfamily P, have roles in mammalian<br/>oncogenesis. This gene may play a role in the development of tumors of the kidney and<br/>larynx. Alternative splicing of this gene produces multiple transcript variants, some encoding<br/>different isoforms.
