**Gene Summary:** The protein encoded by this gene is a G-protein coupled receptor involved in the regulation

of feeding behavior. The encoded protein selectively binds the hypothalamic neuropeptide orexin A. A related gene (HCRTR2) encodes a G-protein coupled receptor that binds orexin A
