Gene Summary:Defensins form a family of antimicrobial and cytotoxic peptides made by neutrophils.<br/>Defensins are short, processed peptide molecules that are classified by structure into three<br/>groups: alpha-defensins, beta-defensins and theta-defensins. All beta-defensin genes are<br/>densely clustered in four to five syntenic chromosomal regions. The protein encoded by this<br/>gene is a beta-defensin with antimicrobial activity against E. coli, S. aureus, and C. albicans.<br/>The encoded protein also binds and neutralizes lipopolysaccharide (LPS), a factor involved in<br/>inflammatory diseases and male reproductive issues.
