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Gene Summary:The protein encoded by this gene is a small GTPase that acts as a homodimer. The encoded<br/>protein is activated by the guanine nucleotide exchange factor PREB and is involved in<br/>protein transport from the endoplasmic reticulum to the Golgi. This protein is part of the<br/>COPII coat complex. Defects in this gene are a cause of chylomicron retention disease<br/>(CMRD), also known as Anderson disease (ANDD). Two transcript variants encoding the same<br/>protein have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Mar 2010]

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
