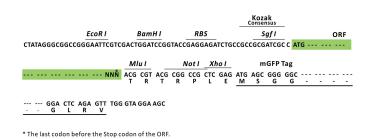

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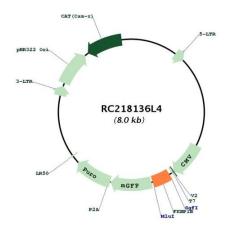

| OTI Annotation:   | This clone was engineered to express the complete ORF with an expression tag. Expression varies depending on the nature of the gene.  |
| Components:   | The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).  |
| Reconstitution Method   | <ol> <li>Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.</li> <li>Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.</li> <li>Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.</li> <li>Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid at the bottom.</li> <li>Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of shipping when stored at -20°C.</li> </ol>  |

| Gene Summary:   | The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the immunophilin protein family, which play<br>a role in immunoregulation and basic cellular processes involving protein folding and<br>trafficking. This encoded protein is a cis-trans prolyl isomerase that binds the<br>immunosuppressants FK506 and rapamycin. It is highly similar to the FK506-binding protein<br>1A. Its physiological role is thought to be in excitation-contraction coupling in cardiac muscle.<br>There are two alternatively spliced transcript variants of this gene encoding different |
