Gene Summary: The protein encoded by this gene was first identified by its ability to bind the adenovirus E1A

protein. The protein localizes to the nucleus. It functions as a transcriptional repressor, and expression of E1A inhibits this repression. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding
