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Gene Summary:	Calpain, a heterodimer consisting of a large and a small subunit, is a major intracellular
	protease, although its function has not been well established. This gene encodes a muscle-
	specific member of the calpain large subunit family that specifically binds to titin. Mutations

in this gene are associated with limb-girdle muscular dystrophies type 2A. Alternate

promoters and alternative splicing result in multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms and some variants are ubiquitously expressed. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]

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
